



Water Treatment Plant Tour Rules

The Skagit PUD water treatment plant and surrounding properties are industrial sites. To ensure a safe and enjoyable visit for all, we require all tour attendees to adhere to the following rules:

- For your safety, listen to and always follow the directions of your Skagit PUD tour guide and any chaperones.
- All attendees must dress appropriately: no slacks, pants, skirts, or dresses that drag on the ground, and all attendees must wear sturdy, closed-toe, skid/slip-resistant shoes with prominent treads on the soles. Sandals, flip-flops, backless, open-toed, and high-heeled shoes must not be worn.
- All attendees must check in and check out with the Skagit PUD tour guide responsible for their tour. Groups may have one person (chaperone, teacher, etc.) coordinate accounting for their group with the Skagit PUD tour guide.
- All attendees must sign an accompanying tour liability release. If the attendee is under the age of 18, the tour liability release must be signed by their parent or legal guardian. **Attendees without a signed tour liability release will not be allowed to take a tour.**
- Attendees are reminded not to let their personal electronic devices distract them from their surroundings on their tour. **Skagit PUD cannot safeguard nor can it be held responsible for loss or damage to personal electronic devices.**
- Attendees must always stay with their assigned group. If an attendee must use the restroom or has other needs, the Skagit PUD tour guide will help accommodate those needs.
- Attendees must not touch any switches, buttons, or equipment at any time. Skagit PUD tour guides will help you understand what is safe to touch and should be asked if you are in doubt.
- In an emergency, the Skagit PUD tour guide will direct attendees to safe areas.
- No smoking is allowed on the grounds during tours.
- No running, shouting, or disorderly conduct of any kind is permitted.
- The maximum tour group size is 30 attendees per Skagit PUD tour guide **and** group-provided chaperone. Dividing groups further on the tour will be at the discretion of the Skagit PUD tour guide.

Failure to follow these rules will result in a stoppage of the tour.
